#### II)EMAS: MC

- Response activity up 10% last December from previous year
- They don't attend to 30% of calls and instead direct the patient elsewhere. As well as 25% of calls attended are treated on scene and/or redirected elsewhere. This is to release some of the pressure at the Hospitals.
- Hospital attendance has only gone up 1% from previous years
- 2426 hours in December for offloading patients (9% of time?)
- Category 2 call was meeting the response time until October when they were averaging 52 minutes per call. Aim for the average was originally to be 18 minutes but was requested up to 30 minutes.
- Junior doctor strike last and this week
- Specialist paramedics have been introduced over the last year. They have 11 in Northants which is more than a lot of other areas.
